CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. In signing and submitting the entry form the artist enters into a contract with the Rotary Club of Millicent Inc. (hereinafter refer to as "the Club") and agrees to all of the following conditions and to hold the Club harmless in the event of any loss or damage whatsoever to the entered works, or the late receipt by the Club of this entry form or of the entered works, and to indemnify the Club in the event of any incorrect description, genuineness or authenticity of or fault of defect in any work submitted.
2. Each entry must have the label (A3) on the back of the work with the full name of the artist, title, category and selling price. Unlabelled works will not be accepted.
3. The Rotary Club of Millicent reserves the right to allow the hanging of works or otherwise in order to maintain the quality of the exhibition; or in the event the exhibition is over subscribed.
4. **Fees** – a non refundable* fee of:
 - a. \$20 per entry.
(*in the event of the event being over-subscribed, entry fees for work that is not hung will be refunded)
 - b. \$10 per entry for Under 19 category.
5. The judge(s) decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. All photographs must be the original work of the entrant and be capable of being hung. **(This will require that all work will be mounted and have D hooks and hanging wire/cord attached).** Works can be framed if desired but not required for entry.
7. **Size of entries:**
 - a. No work submitted may have a length of any side that exceeds 1 metre (including mount/frame).
No exceptions. If used, frames must be rigid.
 - b. All entries for Under 19 Category to be of standard size (8x10), mounted but not framed.
 - c. Primary School student entries to be standard size (6x4), mounted but not framed.
8. Photographers who enter the **Under 19 Category** must be Under 19 yrs at the 1st March 2012.
9. A 20% commission on all sales will be deducted by the Rotary Club of Millicent, and the Club will pay the balance by cheque to the artist. **No GST will be deducted.**
10. All works must be for genuine sale. The Photographer appoints the Club as his/her agent for all purposes associated with exhibition and sale.
11. Photographers agree to images of works being used for publicity purposed relating to the Rotary Photographic Art Show.
12. The Rotary Club of Millicent takes no responsibility for damage or late arrival entries that are delivered, or late collection of works. Nor can it ensure that the packaging in which it was submitted will be returned.
13. The Rotary Club of Millicent bears no responsibility for any loss or damage to artist's property whether before, during or after the exhibition; however the Club will take all reasonable care to reduce any risk, loss or damage to any property or exhibits.
14. Insurance: Artists are advised to take out their own insurance for works during the exhibition duration as well as to and from the venue.
15. All works must be entered on one (1) signed entry form, (a photocopy or electronic data entry form acceptable) and must be accompanied by a digital copy, which may be used for promotional purposes.
16. Entry forms must be submitted to arrive by last post, 29th February, 2012.
All work must be delivered to the Millicent Visitor Information Centre by 20th March, 2012.
17. **No more than six (6) entries will be accepted from any one photographer.** Photographs do not have to be framed. Mounted on mount board and able to be hung is acceptable.

18. The entrant must confirm that they have written permission for the use of any human subject of the parent/guardian of anyone whose image is used in the photograph.
18. Buyers may collect their purchase(s) at the conclusion of the exhibition.
19. Uncollected works: All works not collected by April 11th will no longer be the responsibility of Millicent Rotary Club.
20. Signing of the entry form constitutes acceptance of these conditions of entry.

2. Payments: Cheque made out to Rotary Club of Millicent, Money Order.
Direct deposit details can be emailed to you on request.
3. Fill in the Artwork labels (B) and attach to the back of each photograph before delivery (ensure the labels are on each photograph, not just the packaging).
4. Ensure the information on the Photographic Labels corresponds to the details on the Entry Form.
5. **Entries close on the on 29th February 2012**
Late entries will not be accepted or considered
6. **Photographs entered must be delivered to the Millicent Visitor information Centre, 1 Mt Gambier Rd., Millicent or received by post by 20th March, 2012.**
